

The Bovina Council met for regular meeting on December 13, 2010 at 5:30 pm.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Miller at 5:45 pm followed by a word of prayer by the Mayor.

Those attending were, Mayor Stan Miller, Alderwoman Brenda Riddle, Alderman Richard Villarreal, Alderman David Curtis, City Manager Jana Pitcock, Chief of Police Gary Sinclair, and City Secretary Jade Mahaney. Those not attending the meeting were Alderman Gaylon Rhodes and Alderwoman Celia Tienda.

The motion to approve the minutes from the regular meeting on November 19, 2010 was made by Brenda Riddle and was seconded by Richard Villarreal. The motion passed with no opposition.

The motion to approve account payables was made by Richard Villarreal and seconded by David Curtis. The motion passed with no opposition.

The council reviewed and approved Resolution 101213 denying the rate increase proposed by Southwest Public Service. The motion was made by David Curtis and seconded by Brenda Riddle. The motion passed with no opposition.

The council discussed forming a planning committee for the construction of the Community Center that is to start in the spring of 2011.

Council approved amendments to the City Code concerning Community Service; community serve will be credited at a rate of minimum wage per hour and under special circumstances with supervision, work may be coordinated outside of these hours. The motion to accept changes to Code on Community Service §35.00 was made by Richard Villarreal and seconded by David Curtis. The motion passed with no opposition.

The council reviewed the financial reports for both the City of Bovina and the Municipal Court.

The council set the date for the next meeting on January 13, 2010 at 5:30pm at the Bovina EMS Building.
